Pennsylvania At Risk (PAR) raises awareness about threatened properties that are a representative sampling of the Commonwealth's most endangered historic resources. It is a useful tool to rally support for a local landmark.

BACKGROUND

"Endangerment" is defined as threat of Inappropriate Alteration, Compromised Setting, Physical Deterioration, or Demolition. (See eligibility requirements further below.)
