

Pennsylvania At Risk (PAR) raises awareness about threatened properties that are a representative sampling of the Commonwealth's most endangered historic resources. It is a useful tool for a local group of advocates to use to rally support for a beloved landmark.

ACKGROUND

"Endangerment" is defined as threat of Inappropriate Alteration, Compromised Setting, Physical Deterioration, or Demolition. (See eligibility requirements further below.)

2026 PAR applications must be submitted before midnight on Monday Feburary 9, 2026. Email your submission (or send a link via WeTransfer, Dropbox, Google Drive) to preservationpennsylvania@gmail.com

We expect to announce Pennsylvania At Risk list in April 2026.

LIGIBILITY

Eligibility Requirements

- the property is architecturally, historically and/or culturally significant. (While National Register eligibility/listing is NOT a requirement, National Register criteria for significance are a suggested guide for evaluation. >> https://www.nps.gov/subjects/nationalregister/upload/NRB-15_web508.pdf)
- the property is faced with recognized endangerment either from overt action, neglect, incompatible use, or loss of context.

 Pennsylvania will make a positive impact on preservation efforts


